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The tree of ELT represents some of common divisions that are made in ELT


- 1. The topmost branches : ESP Courses

EAP (English for Academic Purposes) / EOP (English for Occupational Purposes)

3. The next level down :

EST (English for Science and Technology) EBE (English for Business and Economics) ESS (English for the Social Sciences)

- 4. ESP one Branch of EFL (English of Foreign Language) and ESL (English as a second Language)
- 5. Main Branch : ELT
- 6. The root : Communication and Learning



The analogy of a tree can help us to get a bit closer to a definition of ESP.

- A. ESP is not a matter of teaching specialized varieties' of English
- B. ESP is not just a matter of science words and grammar for scientists, Hotel words and grammar for Hotel staff and so on.

Chomsky did with regard to grammar, between *Performance* and Competence, that is between what people actually do with the language and the range of knowledge and abilities which enables them to do it (Hutchinson and Waters, 1981) C. ESP is not different kind from any other form of Language Teaching, In that it should be based in the first instance on principles of **effective and efficient learning.**

Content of learning may vary there is no reason to suppose that the **processes of learning should be** any different for the ESP learners than for GE learners.

Methodology have been applied in ESP classroom.

- ESP that different shapes with ELT
- The base of the ESP that the reason students study foreign language is the form of the base of ESP
